

ORDINANCE NO. 02-03
TOWN OF BAYVIEW
BAYFIELD COUNTY, WISCONSIN
ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE

The Town of Bayview, Bayfield County, State of Wisconsin does hereby ordain the following all terrain vehicle ordinances as per Wisconsin State Statute 23.33(11), which gives the Town of authority to do so.

The definition of an all terrain vehicle which the Town adopts under Wisconsin State Statute 23.33(1)(b) and under the meaning specified under Wisconsin State Statute 340.01(2g) is the following:

All terrain vehicle means an engine driven device which has a net weight of 900 pounds or less, which has a width of 48 inches or less, which is equipped with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and which is designed to travel on 3 or more low pressure tires. A low-pressure tire is a tire which has a minimum width of 6 inches, which is designed to be mounted on a rim with a maximum diameter of 12 inches and which is designed to be inflated with an operating pressure not to exceed 6 pounds per square inch as recommended by the manufacturer.

The Town of Bayview adopts all of Wisconsin State Statutes under Chapter 23.33 and all of the Statutes under Chapter NR 64, which pertain to the regulation of all terrain vehicles in the State of Wisconsin.

The Town of Bayview opens all its roads in its Town which under Wisconsin State Statute 23.33(8)(b) and NR 64.12 gives the Town the authority to do so and in doing so the Town will keep a record of what roads it has opened and properly signed as required under Wisconsin State Statute using the required specific signs designated by the State under Chapter NR 64.12(7)(a) and requirements of signing those said roads opened in its Town. It is then believed that any roads opened as routes in the Town of Bayview are only opened if properly signed. All other roads in the Town, if not properly signed, are then deemed not opened as all terrain vehicles routes and will be considered closed.
