

Town of Bayview Ordinance 19-04

Please take notice, the Town of Bayview Board of Supervisors passed an ordinance regulating peddlers, solicitors and vendors engage in the business of selling, displaying, offering for the sale of any goods, merchandise or services of any kind upon property owned by the Town of Bayview, any State or Town of Bayview road, or the parks or beaches in the Town of Bayview.

Newspaper carriers, farmers who sell agricultural products that they raised or grew, any political speech, canvassers who attempt only to solicit political support or to determine opinions or sentiments, sales made to established businesses by commercial travelers or sales agents in the usual course of business, or to sales made under authority and by order of law, individuals traveling to businesses or houses at the invitation of the resident or the owner, or any operation which is exempted by state or federal statute are excluded from this Ordinance.

All peddlers, vendors and solicitors not exempted shall be required to pay the permit fee of \$100.00. Permit renewals shall be \$100.00. Each permit is valid for 6 months from the date of issue and may be renewed in additional 6 month increments by review of the Town of Bayview Board.

Any person, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity that fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, pay a forfeiture of not more than \$10,000, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each day a violation exists or continues constitutes a separate offense under this ordinance. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.
